

GOVERNOR'S ORDER NO. 12 OF 1931

ORDER PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION FOR QUAIL IN MINNESOTA

Whereas, the Director of Game and Fish of the Minnesota Department of Conservation has investigated the necessity of providing additional protection for quail and has found that this species is in danger of undue depletion,

Therefore, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to authority vested in me by Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 5640, do hereby order that no quail be taken or killed in the State of Minnesota during the year of 1931.
