Dear Sir:

I have the honor to report that the investigation of the State Oil Inspector's Department during the incumbency of John A. McDermott for the period Jan. 1, 1905, to Oct. 31, 1907, is practically concluded. The report showed a discrepancy in the accounts of the Inspector's office, for which he was personally responsible, of \$6,199.95. His attention having been called thereto, he stated that he had been following the precedent established by his predecessors and supposed the same was a perquisite of his office. When informed that there was no statutory provision in support of his contention, he immediately promised to account for the said moneys and has since, from time to time, pending the completion of this report, refunded the entire amount in question.
