


TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

I, James F. Kilty, County Auditor of the County of Washington, in the State of Minnesota, do hereby certify that there has been filed with me by the Village of Mahtomedi, in the County and State aforesaid, a certificate to the effect that a special election was duly called and held in and for said village on the 12th day of October, 1931, at which election there was submitted to the voters to be by them voted upon at said election, the following question:

Shall the Village of Mahtomedi, Washington County, Minnesota, constitute a separate election and assessment district?

That the total number of votes cast at said election was eighty-two, (82); that the total number of votes cast in favor of said question was 71, and the total number of votes cast against said question was eleven, (11), and that the said question was duly carried at said election, and the said Village of Mahtomedi thereby constituted a separate election and assessment district, and I DO HEREBY CERTIFY the ~~to~~ aforesaid facts and the result of the said election to you, so that the same may be received and filed in your office, all in accordance with law.
