CHARTER AMENDMENT

Amend Section 55 as contained in Chapter 8 of the Duluth City Charter, by adding thereto an addition sub-Division Numbered 9, which reads as follows:

"9". Bonds in an amount not exceeding \$250,000.00 for the benefit of the Permanent Improvement Fund, the proceeds thereof to be used only in the payment of the cost of local permanent improvements as shall devolve upon the City.

The bonds issued under authority of this sub-division shall be serial bonds, and shall not be sold at less than the par value thereof, and the principal of which shall be payable in as nearly equal annual serial installments as possible, and in not more than twenty years from their dates. Said bonds shall be payable at such place or places as the Council shall determine, and shall draw a rate of interest not exceeding four and one-quarter (4%) per cent per annum.

The City Council shall annually cause to be levied a tax sufficient in amount to pay such portion of the principal and interest of said bonds as will mature during the next succeeding year."
