
Dear Sir:

Your favor of the 17th inst. advises that according to a report made by Hon. Anton Schaefer, Public Examiner, the sum of \$6,199.95 representing a discrepancy in the accounts of the Hon. John A. McDermott, State Oil Inspector, has been paid in in different amounts since the examination of that office was instituted, beginning presumably about the 4th day of November.
