73 votes cast, and 51 votes were in favor of the above proposition to form a separate election district and 5 votes were against; that the judges of said election duly declared that the said proposition to form a separate election district had been carried and adopted by the voters of said village, and said judges caused their certificate thereof to be filed in the office of the Village Recorder of said village.
