

THE VILLAGE OF MAHTOMEDI DOES HEREBY CERTIFY That a special election was duly called and held in and for said village on the 12th day of October, 1931, at which election there was duly submitted to the voters to be by them voted upon at said election, the following question:

Shall the village of Mahtomedi, Washington County, Minnesota, constitute a separate election and assessment district?

That the Judges of said election duly certified the result thereof to the said Village Council; that the said result as certified by the said Judges shows that at the said election the total number of votes cast was eighty-two (82); that the number of votes cast in favor of the said proposition was seventy-one (71) that the number of votes cast against said proposition was eleven (11); that the Council of said village duly met on the 13th day of October, 1931, and duly canvassed the results of said election, and declared that the result of said election was as above set out, and certified by the Judges, and declared that the question submitted at said election was carried by more than a majority of the voters voting thereon, and that thereby said village of Mahtomedi was constituted a separate election and assessment district, and the Village Council hereby certifies to you the result of said election for the purpose of complying with section 1126 of the General Statutes of the State of Minnesota for the year 1927 (Masons') so that you may certify that fact to the Secretary of State, all in accordance with ^{said} section.


