Sir:

You are herewith respectfully advised that by Royal order of the 31st of December, 1931, I have been transferred from my post as Vice Consul of Sweden at Minneapolis, Minnesota, to Hamburg, Germany, and that I expect to leave Minneapolis in the early part of next March. Mr. Carl Albert Magnus Hallenborg, acting First Secretary in the Foreign Office at Stockholm, has been appointed as my successor. Mr. Hallenborg is expected to arrive at Minneapolis about the first of March to take up his duties as Vice Consul of Sweden as soon as he has received proper Exequatur from the President of the United States, which Exequatur in due time will be filed with your honorable office.
