

R E S O L U T I O N

The following resolution was offered by Commissioner Sangola, seconded by Commissioner Swenson, and unanimously adopted:

Whereas, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 96, Laws of 1931, the electors of the Town of Red Clover, at a special meeting called for the purpose on the 14th day of November, 1931, voted by ballot to dissolve the town organization for the said Town of Red Clover; twentythree (23) ballots having been cast for dissolution and eighth (8) ballots against such dissolution; and,

Whereas, the Town Board of Supervisors of said town, have adopted a resolution setting forth such facts and asking for the dissolution of said town, and a copy of such resolution, duly certified by the town clerk, has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Carlton County, Minnesota; and,

Whereas, the county auditor did give ten days notice by one publication in the Pine Knot, the official newspaper, that the matter of dissolution of the Town of Red Clover, would be considered at a meeting of this board held on Tuesday December 1, 1931; and this board did at that time consider the matter and did hear several persons interested in the matter, and then deferred action thereon until the regular meeting of this board in February, 1932; and this board having now given further consideration to the matter and no opposition having developed;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Carlton County, Minnesota; that the town organization for the said Town of Red Clover is hereby dissolved, and that the territory formerly embraced within the said town, being congressional township forty-nine (49), range twenty (20), hereafter shall be governed as unorganized territory of said Carlton County, Minnesota; and,

Be it further resolved, that for election purposes only the said territory and including also the westerly eighteen sections of township 49, range 19, all being unorganized territory, shall be attached to the Village of Cromwell.
