PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, our country is observing this year the two-hundredth anniversary of the birth of the Father of Our Country, our first president, and


WHEREAS, the young men and young women of the country, led by the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce, have undertaken to mobilize at least 50,000,000 votes at the 1932 elections, as a signal non-partisan and patriotic tribute to the memory of George Washington,

THEREFORE, I, as Governor of Minnesota, do recommend and urge that all qualified voters of this state, of whatever political faith, do register and go to the polls and vote at each and every town, city, state and school election, as a patriotic duty, to aim at the maximum vote from the primaries through the presidential election.

MOREOVER, I do hereby establish the 1932 quota of Minnesota at 1,356,677 votes toward the achievement of this goal, and do recommend and urge that the proper officials in each village, town, city and county do proclaim for their voters a 1932 quota exceeding by 40 per cent their total presidential vote in 1928, and I do request the assistance and support of newspapers, radio stations, periodicals, clubs, lodges and associations, and all other publications and organizations of public opinion, toward the successful execution of this patriotic project.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this 22nd day of March, 1932
