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COPY OF RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE
DISSOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SPRUCE VALLEY

April 5th, 1932

Commissioner Edward Erickson moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

It having been made to appear that the electors of the Town of Spruce Valley in Roseau County, Minnesota, at the annual election held on March 8, 1932, voted by ballot to dissolve its town organization, and that the Town Board thereupon by a resolution duly adopted requested the County Board to dissolve said town, a certified copy of which resolution having been duly presented to the County Board, and due notice having been given of the time set for a hearing on the request for such dissolution, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the town organization of the Town of Spruce Valley in Roseau County, State of Minnesota be and is hereby dissolved, and that from and after this date the said town, being congressional township 164, Range 39, and township 163, range 39 less sections thirty and thirty one, be governed by the statutes relative to unorganized territory in said county.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Ole J. Winjum and upon being put to a vote was by the Chairman declared duly adopted.


