

ORDINANCE NO. 21

An Ordinance extending the village boundaries of the Village of New Germany, Carver County, Minnesota, so as to include certain lands within the village limits of said Village.

The Village Council of the Village of New Germany, Carver County, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1

That it is hereby ordained by the Village Council of the Village of New Germany, Carver County, Minnesota, that the following described unplatted lands, to-wit,

Beginning at a point on the east line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 116 N, Range 26W, Carver County, Minnesota, said point being a distance of 2240 feet north of the southeast corner of said Southwest Quarter of said Section 4; thence west parallel to the south line of the right of way of the Great Northern Railway Company a distance of 1401.18 feet to a point; thence north 2 degrees west a distance of 297.08 feet to the south line of the right of way of the Great Northern Railway Company; thence east along said south line of the right of way of said Great Northern Railway Company a distance of 1408.44 feet to the east line of said Southwest Quarter of said Section #4; thence south along said east line of said Southwest Quarter a distance of 297 feet to the place of beginning which said land so described is less in area than 200 acres,

be and the same is hereby included within the said Village of New Germany and within the limits of said Village of New Germany and that the boundaries of said Village of New Germany be extended so as to include the same.

Section 2.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
