## Table 2a. Estimated

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I have the honor to submit herewith my report of the organization of the Oil Inspector's Department of the State of Minnesota for the period February 1st, 1863, to February 1st, 1864. Fulton S. Warner was Oil Inspector during this period.

For your information: There are five divisions of the Standard Oil Company now by their inspection books to the State of Minnesota from the different divisions, namely Duluth, Mplsco and Minneapolis in Minnesota, Inc., Crookston, West and Fargo, N.D. This report deals exclusively with the Minneapolis division of the Standard Oil Company, consisting of about thirty-one counties, Hennepin and Ramsey included. Mr. Warner has included on his inspection book the receipts from the independent companies in these two counties. In other words, the total amount of money collected on inspection inspection report is the total of what he turned into the State property from the Minneapolis division of the Standard Oil Company. Mr. Warner is entitled to the amount, (not exceeding \$100.00).

I have discussed Mr. Warner with the various press men, who told me the usual statement of the Standard Oil Company was the money that Mr. Warner should be received from the independent companies, as per instructions signed by him, (see exhibit A), namely leaving a shortage of,

At the time I obtained the record of the Oil Inspector's department from Mr. McDermott, I asked him to give me Mr. Warner's deputies' reports, the affidavits of cut-shipments and other records that were necessary to make an examination of that department, but he informed me that Mr. Warner had destroyed them, -- that the only record he left was the oil inspection book. All I received from Mr. McDermott that had any bearing on the Warner investigation was this book, which contains the counties in which the Standard Oil Co. and the independent companies do business in the State of Minnesota; also the number of barrels of oil inspected, the number of barrels of oil shipped outside the state by counties, the amount of money turned over to the State Treasurer and the names of the deputies who made the inspections.

On or about January 6th, 1906, I asked Miss Grace Murphy, who was appointed a stenographer under Mr. McDermott about January 15th, 1905, if she knew where Mr. Warner's records were, and her testimony in this phase of the report you will find on page 26.

I obtained from the State Auditor the abstracts containing the amount of money turned over to the State Treasurer monthly, which read in effect, as follows:

The amount of money paid by the Standard Oil Company, all stations, (which means the five divisions of the Standard Oil Co.)

This is followed by the amount of money turned in by the independent companies in Hennepin and Ramsey counties, which is also included in the Minneapolis division of the Standard Oil Company.

Then I obtained from the Standard Oil Company the amount of money paid Mr. Warner for oil inspected in the Minneapolis division. My report is based on this information, i.e., the Oil Inspector's book, the abstracts turned in to the State Auditor by Mr. Warner,

and also the money paid to Mr. Warner by the Standard Oil Company for oil inspected in the Minneapolis division.

With the foregoing information, I believe this report is self-explanatory.

In regard to Denton C. Warner's expense account, which amounts to \$2424.00, I wish to inform you that Mr. Warner's personal expenses have been allowed by the State Auditor without sub-verdicts, we have also the expenses of his dependents. The only record accompanying the same is a receipt, the following being a sample:

"St. Paul, Minn. AUG 1, 1903:  
Received of D. C. Warner, State Oil Inspector, \$100.00.  
Transportation, traveling expenses, supplies and  
material. (Signed) D.C. Warner."

Out-Shipments:

In regard to the out-shipments of oil, Assistant Attorney General, Geo. H. Peterson, addressed the following opinion to this Department on April 3rd:

"Your favor of April 3rd, addressed to this Department, has been referred to me. I quote your letter as follows:-  
"In your classification of the official records of the Oil Inspector's Department, I find as an illustration, the following entry:- 'out-shipments for the month of Oct., 1903, 3,000 bbls.'  
"Let me here state that by 'out-shipments' is meant, shipments of oil going into the state, which, although inspected in this state, are afterwards sent out of the state, and not consumed in the state, and for which deductions are necessarily proper. These deductions are obtained by the filling of sworn affidavits by the oil companies covering the out-shipments.  
"The above affidavit will not signing. In my report of examinations into the records of the oil Inspector's department, please advise me whether I shall include the 'out-shipment' under 'Affidavets.'

To answer thereto I have to advise you that the general rule of evidence is, contra propositum contra probatorem - every presumption is made against the wrongdoer. This is based upon the principle that the conduct of the wrongdoer is attributed to his supposed knowledge that the truth would have operated against him.

Using this rule of construction, I have the honor to advise you that until your examination develops facts to the contrary, it is proper for you to include the "out-shipments" in question under "shortages."

Illegal Expenses:

Questioning the legality of expenses paid by the State of Minnesota to Mr. Warner's deputies, Mr. Peterson, Asst. Attorney General, on April 2nd addressed the following opinion to this department:

"Hon. A. Schaefer,  
Public Examiner.

Dear Sir:- This office is in receipt of your favor of April 1st, in which you inquire -

1. What is the proper construction to be placed on Section 3 of Chapter 123 S.L. 1901, regulating the compensation of deputy oil inspectors?
2. During what period was said provision in effect?
3. During said period were deputy oil inspectors entitled to expenses?

In answer to your first query your attention is called to said Section 3 of Chapter 123, infra, which, as far as material, reads as follows:-

"Said deputies are hereby authorized and empowered to collect and receipt for all fees earned by them that are now, or may be hereafter, provided by law for the inspection of oils, and shall, when making their monthly reports to the state inspector, as provided in section five of this act, include in such report a verified statement of all money received by them, and shall account for any pay over, at the time of making such report, all sums collected by them to the state inspector. Said deputy inspectors shall receive no compensation for their said services a salary not to exceed one hundred dollars per month, the same to be paid and proportioned by the state inspector upon the basis of the fees earned and collected by the deputy during the preceding month; but in no case shall the deputy's salary exceed seventy-five per centum of the amount of fees earned by him during the preceding month unless said seventy-five per centum will amount to less than fifty dollars per month, in which case such deputy shall be entitled to receive so much of the fees earned by him, if sufficient therefor, as will equal said sum of fifty dollars, but in no case shall he receive more than the amount of fees earned and collected by him."

You are advised that said statute shall be interpreted as follows:

A -The deputy oil inspector shall receive seventy-five per cent of his fees, limited however to the sum of \$100 per month. As a practical problem, in case the inspection fees equal or exceed \$125.33 the salary of the deputy is \$100. In case the fees are less than \$125.33 or equal or exceed \$66.66 the salary is seventy-five per cent of such fees, said salary ranging from \$50 to \$100 accordingly.

B -In case seventy-five per cent of the fees collected in any month is less than \$50 then the deputy shall receive \$50, provided the total fees equal or exceed \$50. Thus, in case the fees range from \$50 to \$125.33 the salary is \$50 per month.

C -In case the fees are less than \$50 per month the deputy shall receive such fees and no more.

3. In answer to your second query you are advised that Section 4 of said Chapter 128, suna, provides as follows:-

Chapter 20 of the Revised Laws of 1906 entitled "Inspector of Oils," supplanted Chapter 128, suna, and became effective Mar. 1st, 1906. You are accordingly advised that Section 3 of Chapter 128, suna, covering the compensation of deputy oil inspectors, was in effect from January 1st, 1906 until March 1st, 1906.

3. In answer to your third query I call your attention to the following language taken from said Section 3 of Chapter 128, suna, to-wit:

"For the payment of the salaries of the state and deputy inspectors, as provided in this act, and in procuring and furnishing such implements or instruments for testing oils, or for branding, or for blanks, or for traveling expenses necessarily incurred by the state inspector or illuminating oils, as may be necessary and suitable to carry out the provisions and intent of this act, the sum of \$20,000, or so much thereto as may be necessary, shall be out of hereby annually appropriated out of the illuminating oil inspection fund herein provided for, and all payments made pursuant hereto shall be charged to and paid out of the said illuminating oil inspection fund hereby created; provided that no payments shall be made hereunder except upon the warrant of the state auditor, and such warrant shall issue only upon the certificate of the state inspector filed with the state auditor, both in respect to salaries, as herein provided, and to disbursements authorized by the provisions of this act; provided, that nothing in this act contained shall be construed as waiving the right of the state to maintain a civil action, or civil actions, for the recovery of the fees earned by the chief inspector or his deputies, under the provisions of this act."

My opinion is that the traveling expenses necessarily incurred by the state inspector of illuminating oils" are "disbursements authorized by the provisions of this act," but that the expenses of the deputies, except "in procuring and furnishing such implements or instruments for testing oils, for branding, or for blanks", are without authority of law and no charge against the State.

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Bonds:

In regard to Mr. Warner's bond, I quote the assistant Attorney General's opinion dated Apr. 3rd, 1908:

"Hon. A. Schaefer,  
Public Examiner.

Dear Sir:- Your favor of April 3rd addressed to this Department has been referred to me.

You enclose the official bond of Fenton G. Warner, State Oil Inspector during the years 1903-4, in the penal sum of \$5,000; the said bond covering said term of office, is dated December 31, 1902, and the surety upon the bond is the National Surety Company of New York, and said bond was filed Jan. 12, 1903.

You state that an examination discloses that Fenton G. Warner, State Oil Inspector, as aforesaid, is short in his accounts about the sum of \$14,000, and you inquire if the Surety Company can now be held for this shortage.

In answer thereto I have the honor to advise you that, in my opinion, the bond is a valid one and the surety thereon is liable, subject to the limitations in the penalty of the bond, to-wit - \$5,000.
