We, the undersigned, Judges of the Annual Village Election of the Village of Grasston, in the Town of Grass Lake, of the County of Kanabec and State of Minnesota do hereby certify as follows to-wit:

That the hereto attached Exhibits, marked "Exhibit A" and Exhibit B" are true and correct copies of what it purports to be copies.

That Exhibit A is a true and correct copy of the Notice of the annual Village Election held in the Village of Grasston in said County and State on the 10th, day of March, A. D. 1908, plainly submitting to the Electors of the Village of Grasston the question of becoming a separate Election and Assessment District in pursuance of the provisions of Section 708 Revised Laws of 1905.

That Exhibit B is a true and correct copy of the ballot used to vote on the question of forming a separate election and assessment District of the Village of Grasston.

We further certify that the ballots presented by the Electors at said annual Village election for the purpose of voting upon said question of separation of the Village of Grasston from the Town of Grass Lake for Election and Assessment purposes, were deposited in a separate ballot box; that after the polls were closed we did publicly count and canvass said ballots; that the total number of ballots cast at said election on said question of separation was Twenty-one (21);

That there was cast Twenty-one (21) votes in favor of separating the Village of Grasston from the Town of Grass Lake for Election and assessment purposes

That there was no votes cast against separating the Village of Grasston from the Town of Grass Lake for election and assessment purposes.

That the question of separating the Village of Grasston from the Town of Grass Lake ~~xxxxxx~~ was carried by a majority of Twenty-one votes and so publicly proclaimed to the voters by the Clerk of Election.
