

RESOLUTION.

Whereas the Village Council of the village of Lindstrom, Minnesota by a resolution, dated on February 17th 1908, proposed the relinquishment of the organization of said village and the reincorporation thereof under the Revised Laws of Minnesota of 1905, and ordered a Special election to be held thereon; and whereas, upon due notice given such Special Election was duly held in said village on Tuesday the tenth day of March 1908, and resulted in the following votes cast, viz:

For reincorporation-----Yes---36 votes

No----7 Notes

Be it therefore resolved, that the Village of Lindstrom hereby relinquishes its organization under which it has heretofore existed, and is now reincorporated under the Revised Laws of Minnesota of the year 1905 and the amendments thereof.
