WRIT AND PROCLAMATION OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR FROM THE FIFTY_THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT OF THE STATE

To the People of the State of Minnesota and particularly to the Fifty-third Senatorial District of said State; to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota; to the County Auditors of the Counties of Crow Wing and Morrison of said State; to all Election Officials of said Fifty-third Senatorial District and of the Several Precincts and Election Districts in said Senatorial District; and to all Others Whom it May Concern; GREETING:

WHEREAS a vacancy now exists in the office of State Senator from the Fifty-third Senatorial District of the State, caused by the death of the late State Senator C. Rosenmeier; and

WHEREAS there has not been and will not be any session of the Legislature between the happening of said vacancy and the next General Election:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting under authority and direction of Section 17 of Article 4 of the Constitution of the State and the statutes in such case provided, do hereby direct that a special election be held in said Fifty-third Senatorial District on the next General Election day, to-wit: Tuesday, the Eighth day of November, 1932, to fill the vacancy existing in said office; that candidates for said office be nominated on the next Primary Election day, to-wit: Monday, the Twentieth day of June, 1932; that notice of said election and the primary therefor, the nomination and election of candidates and the conduct of said elections be had and all things pertaining thereto be done as provided by Chapter 297 Session Laws of Minnesota for 1929, and amendments thereof, and other applicable provisions of law.

IN VITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed and have hereunto set my hand at the Capitol in the City of St. Paul, this 6th day of June, 1932.
