


I HEREBY APPOINT John I. Levin, of St. Paul, Minnesota, as special attorney for the state agricultural society to act on the state fair grounds during the fair to be held from September 3rd to September 10th, 1932, and for such time as may be necessary thereafter to act at that place, action to be taken in all matters that require the immediate action of an adviser to the state agricultural society or of a prosecuting attorney.

This appointment is made upon recommendation of the board of managers of the state agricultural society and upon my judgment that the public welfare will be promoted thereby. The compensation is hereby fixed at \$15.00 per day, to be paid from the funds of said society.




