

R E S O L U T I O N

The following resolution was offered by Commissioner Scott, seconded by Commissioner Sangola, and unanimously adopted:

Whereas, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 96, Laws of 1931, the electors of the Town of Corona, at a special meeting called for the purpose on the 12th day of July, 1932, voted by ballot to dissolve the town organization for the said Town of Corona: thirty (30) ballots having been cast for dissolution and nine (9) ballots against such dissolution: and,

Whereas, the Town Board of Supervisors of said town, have adopted a resolution setting forth such facts and asking for the dissolution of said town, and a copy of such resolution, duly certified by the town clerk, has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Carlton County, Minnesota: and,

Whereas, the County Auditor did give ten days notice by one publication in the Star Gazette, the official newspaper, that the matter of dissolution of the Town of Corona, would be considered at a meeting of this board held on Tuesday, September 6, 1932: and this board did at that time consider the matter and no opposition having developed;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Carlton County, Minnesota: that the town organization for the said Town of Corona is hereby dissolved, and that the territory formerly embraced within the said town, being Congressional Township Forty-Eight (48), Range Nineteen (19), hereafter shall be governed as unorganized territory of said Carlton County, Minnesota: and,

Be it further resolved, that for election purposes only the said territory shall be attached to the Town of Eagle.
