COVERNOR'S ORDER NO. 5 OF 1932

EXTENDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION TO MIGRATORY GAME BIRDS IN THAT PORTION OF MARSHALL COUNTY, MINNESOTA, HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED:

Whereas, it has been represented to the Director of Game and Fish that migratory game birds are in danger of undue deplotion in that portion of Marshall County, Minnesota, hereinafter described, and

Whereas, the Director of Game and Fish has presented me with the result of his investigation and has recommended that additional protection be given migratory game birds in said portion of Marshall County, Minnesota, to prevent their undue depletion, and

Whereas, I find that there is danger of undue depletion of migratory game birds in said area.

Now, therefore, I. Floyd B. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to authority vested in me by Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 5640, do hereby order that no migratory game birds be taken in that portion of Harshall County, State of Minnesota, during the year 1932, hereinafter described, to wit:

All of Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 and 26, North 3/4 of Section 27, North 1/2 of Section 28 and North 1/4 of Section 36, all in Township 158 N., R. 41 W.; South 1/2 of Section 18, Township 158 N., R. 40 W. All of Section 19, South 1/2 of Section 20, South 1/2 of Section 21, Southwest 1/4 of Section 22, Southwest 1/4 of Section 25, South 1/2 of Section 31, all of Sections 27, 28, 29, 30, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, all in Township 158 N., R. 40 W.

This order shall remain in force until December 31, 1932, unless sooner revoked or medified.
