

Proposed Amendment of Section (1), Chapter 5,
of the City Charter of the City of Hastings, Minn.

Sec. 1. All property, real and personal, except such as may be exempt by the laws of this state or by ordinances of the city, shall be subject to taxation for the purpose of constructing, repairing, and improving of streets, roads and bridges, and all other needful improvements, and for other purposes conducive of good order, cleanliness and protection against crime, disease, and fire and for the support of the city government and the payment of its debts and liabilities, incurred on account of and for the purposes above mentioned, and the same shall be assessed, levied, and collected in the manner provided by the law of this state for the assessment and collection of county or state taxes; provided that said taxes shall in no one year exceed Twenty-five mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of the property in said city.

All provisions inconsistent herewith in said charter are hereby repealed.
