BEIDELMAN being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says that he is and at all times hereinafter mentioned was, vice president of the Heinrich Chemical Company, a corporation organized under and by virtue of the laws of Minnesota. That its principal place of business is in the City of Minneapolis in said state.

Affiant further states that on or about the 15th day of October 1932, the said Heinrich Chemical Company, Inc. purchased from the Springfield Fire & Marine Insurance Company of Springfield, Massachusetts by and through its agent or agency, Marsh & McLennan, Inc., a policy of insurance, which said policy of insurance was designated as a Minnesota standard policy No. 27197, and which policy was intended to indemnify the Heinrich Chemical Company for or by reason of any damage to property of said Heinrich Chemical Company if the same be injured by fire within one year after the issuance of said policy of insurance, and for which policy of insurance, the said Heinrich Chemical Company, Inc. agreed to pay and did thereafter pay the sum of Seventy-six (\$76.00) Dollars; said policy being in an amount of Five Thousand (\$5,000) Dollars.

Affiant further states that he is informed and verily believes that the said Springfield Fire & Marine Insurance Company has, during the past three years, sold thousands of policies of like or similar character within the territorial confines of the State of Minnesota, and that it has received in payment for said policies, premiums from the various assureds therein and at all times during the past three years, the said Springfield

Fire & Marine Insurance Company has been and now is doing business within the confines of the State of Minnesota contrary to law and without compliance with the statutes of Minnesota relating to foreign corporations, and that affiant is further informed and verily believes that at this time, the said Springfield Fire & Marine Insurance Company is operating its said business within the State of Minnesota without compliance and in contravention of the foreign corporation laws of said state.

Affiant further states that this affidavit is made for the purpose of bringing to the attention of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota such facts in order that prosecution may be commenced under and by virtue of Section 7494 and 7495 and that such facts be transmitted to the County Attorney of Hennepin County for appropriate action in accordance with said statute.
