

In order to bring the data on public schools in Minnesota up to date the following statement is prepared as of June 30th, 1932.

The State's Contribution to Public Schools

FIRST - The semi-annual apportionment of the General School Fund computed by the State Department of Education and distributed by the State through the County Treasurer twice a year, in the Fall and in the Spring, to all public school districts maintaining school at least seven months during the year. This distribution is based on the number of pupils attending school at least forty days. The amount per pupil for last year was \$7.50; the total \$3,898,135.00.

This money comes from two sources -- the income (interest) from invested permanent school trust funds, and the proceeds of the State one mill tax. The first source nets approximately \$2,600,000.00 a year, the latter \$1,800,000.00. Of this latter sum the amount of \$500,000.00 annually is transferred to the Special State Aid Fund.

SECOND - Special State Aid to Schools, Classes and Departments amounting to \$6,731,352.08 (including \$181,930.50 Federal Aid) for the year 1932 and distributed as follows:

Funds for the payment of Special Aid to Schools are appropriated by the legislature out of the States revenue fund. For a more detailed statement of school aid payments see mimeographed copy of listing of Special State Aid to Public Schools of Minnesota for the School Year ending July 31st, 1932.

State Revenue Fund

This fund is raised partly from a direct property state tax but by far the greater amount comes from Gross Earnings Tax on Railroad, Insurance, Telegraph, Telephone, Express, Freight Line and Sleeping

Car Companies, Inheritance Taxes, Occupation and Royalty tax on Iron Ore etc. The receipts for the year ending June 30th, 1932 according to the State Auditor's report amounted to a total of \$22,299,571.17. Of this \$5,576,875.67 was raised by direct state taxes. The other \$16,722,695.50 credited to this Fund is collected from other sources of which the following are some of the larger items:

\*\*Note: The law provides that one-half of the income (interest) from the Swamp Land Fund shall be added to the General School (Apportionment) Fund. The other half is distributed to the State University, State Teachers Colleges and State charitable institutions. It may therefore be taken for granted that one-half of the Swamp Land Fund accumulations, or \$5,781,785.93 should be added to the Permanent School Fund accumulations, making a total of \$68,957,256.84 in the School Trust Funds.

The law, as amended in 1927, provides for grants to schools and departments in brief as follows:

1. Classification Aid -- to a four-year high school, \$810; high school department \$180 for one high school teacher; \$360 for two and \$540 for three or more; Junior High, \$360; Senior High \$540; graded elementary with 8 school years of 9 months, \$450; with 6 school years of 9 months, \$360; ungraded elementary with 8 months' term \$135 for each first grade teacher and \$90 for each second grade teacher; to school with 7 months' term, three-fourths of this sum. In no case to exceed \$270 to an ungraded elementary school except a SUPERIOR school which may receive an additional sum of \$112.50 annually.
2. Supplemental Aid -- to districts where a 20 mill levy for maintenance does not yield \$40 per pupil, the State pays the difference between the amount raised and \$40 per pupil, less 10%. Additional per teacher aid is also granted under certain conditions to districts maintaining only ungraded elementary schools.
3. Aid to Special Departments -- Agriculture, \$720; General Industrial, Home Economics, Commercial Training, \$450 each.
4. Aid to Classes for Defectives -- Deaf, \$225 for resident and \$360 for non-resident; Blind, \$270 per pupil; Sub-Normal, \$90 per pupil; Defective Speech not to exceed \$1,350 for each teacher; Classes for Crippled Children \$225 per pupil.
5. Transportation Aid -- to consolidated school districts for transporting pupils not to exceed \$4,000 annually for each school, less 10%. For transporting isolated pupils not to exceed \$50 annually for each pupil, less 10%. Also for transporting Crippled Children not to exceed \$150 annually for each child and not to exceed \$20,000 for any one year.
6. Building Aid -- to consolidated school districts not to exceed \$3,000 for each new building erected, less 10%.
7. For Association -- to a central school, \$180 for each associated rural school and \$45 to the rural school district.
8. Tuition Aid -- tuition payments for non-resident high school pupils coming from districts where no high school facilities are provided, \$7 per month for each such pupil not to exceed ten months in any school year.
9. Aid to Teacher Training Departments in High Schools -- reimbursement for salaries and other expenses in connection with such departments, the total not to exceed \$225,000 annually.
- 10 & 11. Federal Aid under the Smith-Hughes and George-Reed Acts for vocational education and for the preparation of teachers of Agricultural, Trade, Industrial and Home Economics subjects.
12. Evening School Aid -- reimbursement to school districts of one-half the salary paid to teachers of evening schools for adults.
13. Gross Earnings Tax Aid -- To school districts wherein at least 20% of the property is railroad property and therefore exempt from local taxation under the Gross Earnings Tax Law.
14. Library Aid -- reimbursement for library book purchase not to exceed \$20 for each teacher with a maximum of \$40 each building.
