OF THE VOTE FOR PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS

We, the undersigned, electors of President and Vice President of the United States of America, for the respective terms beginning on the Fourth day of March, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-three, being electors duly and legally elected, appointed and qualified by and for the State of Minnesota, as appears by the annexed list of electors, made, certified and delivered to us by the Governor of the State of Minnesota, having met and convened at the Capitol in the City of St. Paul in the State of Minnesota, in pursuance of the directions of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, and in conformity with the laws and the constitution of the United States, on the first Wednesday, being the Fourth day of January, A. D. 1933.

DO HEREBY CERTIFY, That, being so assembled and duly organized, we proceeded to vote by ballot, and balloted first for President and then for Vice President, by distinct ballots;

AND WE FURTHER CERTIFY, That the following are two distinct lists; one, of the votes for President; and the other, of the votes for Vice President; so cast as aforesaid:
