


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Harry H. Peterson, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes for 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint Roland Quinn of St. Paul, Minnesota, to be a special attorney for the Commissioner of Highways as a right-of-way counsel in the right-of-way department; and I hereby fix his compensation in the sum of \$2400.00 per annum to be paid from and out of the appropriation made for the State Commissioner of Highways. Said appointment to commence on January 23, 1933 and ending the first Monday in January, 1935, unless sooner removed.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 21st day of January, 1933.


