PROCLAMATION


WHEREAS, It is most fitting and desirable that the nations of the western Hemisphere designate a date when they may demonstrate the cordial relations which have always existed between them, and

WHEREAS, The Pan American Union has proclaimed April 14th as PAN AMERICAN DAY-- the Day of the Americas-- and


WHEREAS, It seems only proper that citizens of our state should actively participate in the observance of this occasion,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 14, 1933 as PAN AMERICAN DAY, and do urgently request that our people prominently display the flag of the United States on that day, and in other ways observe Pan American Day with appropriate ceremonies.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the great seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this 25th day of March, 1933.
