CERTIFICATE OF CONSENT

To the Secretary of Agriculture of the United States; to the office of the Solicitor and Wayland W. Sanford, as Assistant Attorney to the Solicitor of the United States Department of Agriculture; to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota; and to all others Whom It May Concern; GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, under authority of the Act of Congress of March 1, 1911 (36 Stat., 961), as amended by Section 6 of the Act of Congress of June 7, 1927 (43 Stat., 653), the Secretary of Agriculture, has purchased in the name of the United States, certain lands situated in the State of Hinnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:

A certain list of lands purchased by the Bovernment in Superior National Forest purchase unit in St. Louis County, as follows:

The Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW2 SE4) in Section Twenty-eight (28), and the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW2 NE4) in Section Thirty-three (23), all in Township Sixty-four (64) North, of Range Sixteen (16) West, and

WHEREAS, the title to said lands has been examined by the above named attorney, who is familiar with all the instruments and proceedings whereby the United States acquired the same, and

WHEREAS, good and sufficient deeds of conveyance, approved by the Attorney General of the United States, of each tract and partial thereof have been delivered to the United States and have been recorded in the office of the register of deeds of the county in which said lands are situated, and

WHIRFAS, the agreed consideration for said lands has been paid by the United States to the respective grantors thereof, and proof has been made that title to all of such lands has been duly vested in the United States.

NOW THEREFORE, I. Floyd B. Olson, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to the provisions of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Chapter 1. Section 6, do hereby consent to such acquisition by the United States and issue this certificate of consent in duplicate, conditioned as in such chapter prescribed,

one of which shall be delivered to the officer presenting the application and the other filed with the Secretary of State.
