PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the General Statutes of the State of Minnesota provide that the Friday preceding Easter Sunday, known as Good Friday, is a legal holiday and that no public business shall be transacted on such day except in case of necessity;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of Minnesota, proclaim that

FRIDAY, APRIL 14, 1933
may be observed by the citizenry of the State of Minnesota as such legal holiday.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be hereto affixed this 13th day of April, A. D. 1933.
