

DISSOLUTION PIONEER TOWNSHIP

The following resolution was submitted by Commissioner Eruber who moved its adoption:

It having been made to appear that the electors of the Town of Pioneer in Lake of the Woods County, Minnesota, at the special election held March 28th, 1933, voted by ballot to dissolve its town organization, and that the Town Board thereupon by resolution duly adopted requested the County Board to dissolve said town, a certified copy of which resolution having been duly presented to the County Board, and due notice having been given of the time set for a hearing on the request for such dissolution, said time of hearing being the time and date hereof and no one appearing in opposition to said dissolution, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That the town organization of the Town of Pioneer in Lake of the Woods County, State of Minnesota be and is hereby dissolved, and that from and after this date the said town, being congressional township 157, Range 32, be governed by the Statutes relative to unorganized territory in said county.

Resolution was supported by Commissioner Zauche and duly adopted.
