KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Harry H. Peterson, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint Norbert Wilwerscheid as office assistant to Mr. O. T. Bundlie, Assistant Attorney General assigned to the Department of Highways, to compile information for the establishment of a division relative to the driver's license law and the financial responsibility of motor vehicle owners in accordance with Chapter 351 and 352, Laws of 1933, and I hereby fix his compensation in the sum of \$200.00 per month to be paid from and out of the appropriation made for the State Commissioner of Highways; said appointment to commence on June 1, 1933 and end on the first Monday in January, 1935, unless sooner removed.


