

ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY
TO VILLAGE.

The Village Council of the Village of Rush City, Chisago County, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1 - That the certain tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the County of Chisago, State of Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-one (21), lying North of the so-called "Rush City- St Croix Road", containing Four and one-third (4 $\frac{1}{3}$) acres, more or less;

which said land and premises lie adjacent and contiguous to said village be and the same are hereby annexed to the Village of Rush City, Chisago County, Minnesota.

Section 2 - That this ordinance take effect immediately the publication following/of the same and the filing of a certified copy thereof with the Secretary of State.



ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO VILLAGE
The Village Council of the Village of Rush City, Chisago County, Minnesota do ordain as follows:
Section 1—That the certain tract of parcel of land situated, lying and being in the County of Chisago, State of Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:
All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE¹/₄ of NW¹/₄) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-one (21), lying North of the so-called "Rush City-St. Croix Road", containing Four and one-third (4-1/3) acres, more or less,
which said land and premises lie adjacent and contiguous to said village and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Rush City, Chisago County, Minnesota.
Section 2—That this ordinance take effect immediately following the publication of the same and the filing of a certified copy of same in the office of the State Auditor.

Merrill F. Sherman being duly sworn, deposes and says that he now is and during all the times hereinafter mentioned has been the publisher or printer in charge of the Rush City Post, a weekly newspaper, printed and published in the village of Rush City, in said Chisago County, State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week;
That he has knowledge of the facts and knows personally that the printed

Ordinance hereto attached, cut from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once in each week for weeks, and that all of said publications were made in the English language.
That said notices was first inserted, printed and published on Friday the 9th day of

June, 1933 and was printed and published in said newspaper on each and every Friday

thereafter until and including, Friday the 9th day of June, 1933.

That during all the times aforesaid, said newspaper was qualified as a medium of official and legal publications as required by sections 3 and 4 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921, and that it has complied with all the requirements that constitute a legal newspaper as defined in said sections 3 and 4, to-wit: that for more than one year last past, from the date of the first publication of said

Ordinance said newspaper has been: (1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language, and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with six columns to the page, each nineteen and three quarters inches long.

(2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same.

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the first publication of said

Ordinance the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said county of Chisago, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921.

That the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z both inclusive, of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisement hereunto attached, viz:
