

Be it Resolved, by the village council of the Village of Rosemount, Dakota County, Minnesota, that at a special village election held in said village of Rosemount, pursuant to a resolution of this council, and pursuant to due notice of holding such election first given, which special election was held on the 19th day of October, 1908, the question of relinquishing the charter of the village and being thenceforth governed by the general laws of the state, as provided by Chapter 9 of the Revised Laws 1905 and amendments thereto, was duly submitted to the legal voters of said village.

That at said election there were cast in all twenty five (25) votes.

That twenty five (25) of said votes cast were in the affirmative, and none of said votes were in the negative.

Be it Further Resolved, that a majority of all votes cast at said election were in the affirmative and in favor of relinquishing the charter of the village

Passed and adopted this 19th day of October, 1908.
