HARRY L. CAWLEY, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that: Prior to July 5th, 1933, he was duly appointed by the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to Chapter 417, Laws of 1931, as supervisor of census, and Ernest Drew, R. T. Elstad, Thos. C. Cassidy, Joe. Kovach, John J. Sterle, J.L. Barnidge, Donald E. Johnson, Wm. Johnson, C.E. Fleming, William Suhonen, Richard J. Letsch and Eric A. Lindstrom, all of Independent School District No. 40, of St. Louis County and the State of Minnesota, were duly appointed by said Secretary of State, pursuant to said act, as duly appointed enumerators of the said census, and that he and the above mentioned enumerators were directed by the Secretary of State aforesaid to take a census of the residents of Independent School District No. 40, St. Louis County, Minnesota.

He further deposes and says that; thereafter, he and the said enumerators agreed in writing and under oath to perform their duties in connection with said census faithfully and impartially and under the direction of said Secretary of State, as more fully appears from exhibits hereto attached and made a part hereof.

He further deposes and says that between the dates of May 24th and June 29th, 1933, all of the inhabitants of said school district were interviewed by one of the above named enumerators, working under his supervision:

He further deposes and says that as a result of said census, it appears that there were on June 29th, 1933, twice thousand thirty seven residents (9,337) of said School District.

He further deposes and says that after the said enumeration of the inhabitants of said District, each of the above named enumerators and this deponent executed an affidavit to the effect that the facts stated in said cards were true to the best of their knowledge and belief. Said affidavits are hereto attached and made a part hereof.
