OPINION

The above matter came on for hearing before the Court at the County Court House at Virginia, Minnesota on the 17th day of June, 1933. It appeared from the evidence that a certain Charter of the City of Tower was duly adopted on the 18th day of June, 1928; that said original Charter was lost and is not now in existence; that certain printed copies of said Charter were printed; that said printed copies are true and exact copies of said original Charter; and that duplicate copies of said original Charter have not been filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds of St. Louis County, Minnesota as provided for by law.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that printed copies of said original Charter that are true and correct copies of Petitioner's Exhibit "A" hereto attached be filed and recorded in place of original duplicates of said ~~original~~ Charter as provided by the Statutes and Constitution of the State of Minnesota.
