
For the purpose of assisting the President of the United States in speeding national recovery and, at the request of the Minnesota Truck Owners' Association, the Regulated Motor Transportation Association of Minnesota, the Twin City Transfer Mens' Association, and the Livestock Haulers' Association of Minnesota

I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim that a meeting will be held at the Municipal Auditorium, Minneapolis, Minnesota, on the 15th day of August, 1933, for the purpose of preparing and adopting a code relating to wages and hours for employees engaged in the motor transportation of goods and for the selection of two representatives to participate in the promulgation of a national code to be later submitted to the President of the United States pursuant to the National Industrial Recovery Act.


The National Recovery Administration has requested that the code to be submitted respecting wages and hours represent the views of all users of trucks in the transportation of property, including those who own and operate trucks in the transportation of their own goods as well as those engaged in the business of the transportation of property for hire. One representative from each of said groups will be selected.

All owners of trucks, excluding those specifically exempted by the National Recovery Act, are requested to attend the meeting.
