


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Harry H. Peterson, attorney general of the state of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes for 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint John La Due to be a special attorney for the commissioner of highways as an attorney in the legal division of the Attorney General's office, in the Highway Department, claims department, and I hereby fix his compensation in the sum of \$200.00 per month to be paid from and out of the appropriation made for the state commissioner of highways. Said appointment to commence on August 7, 1933, and ending the first Monday in January, 1935, unless sooner removed.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 4th day of August, 1933.


