KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Harry H. Peterson, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes for 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint Joseph A. Poirier of St. Paul, Minnesota, as special counsel for the Commissioner of Highways; and I hereby fix his compensation in the sum of \$4,000.00 per annum to be paid from and out of the appropriation made for the State Commissioner of Highways. Said appointment to commence on September 18, 1933 and ending the first Monday in January, 1935, unless sooner removed.
