PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Minnesota has resolved that October 11th of each year shall be observed as "General Pulaski's Memorial Day", and

WHEREAS, October 11, 1933 marks the One Hundred and Fifty Fourth anniversary of the death of General Casimir Pulaski, Revolutionary War hero, and

WHEREAS, It is most fitting that recognition should be given to the memory of this illustrious son of Poland, who rendered such valuable assistance to the cause of American freedom, and who died on October 11, 1779 of wounds received in that struggle,

THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby designate Wednesday, October 11, 1933 as "Pulaski Memorial Day", and urge its observance by the people of this State, with such ceremonies as may be deemed appropriate; and I also request public officials and people generally to display the flag of the United States on that day.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be hereto affixed this 9th day of October, 1933.
