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An ordinance of the Council of the Village of Barry, Minnesota, so as to include therein the 10th section 10, Chapter 47, in the State of Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Barry, Minn., do hereby enact as follows:

That whereas heretofore and on the 1st day of February 1909 there was duly and lawfully presented to the Council of said Village of Barry, Minnesota, a petition in writing which is on file with the records of said Village, signed and executed by ~~James J. Barry, William Barry, James Barry, and E. A. Barry~~ active and petitioners of the Council of the said Village of Barry, Minnesota, to extend the boundaries of said Village, so as to include the 10th section 10, Chapter 47, in the State of Minnesota.

And whereas it has been duly presented to the said Council by said petition and by other sufficient proof that the above described real property abuts upon the said Village of Barry; that the said petition was signed by ~~E. J. Barry, William Barry, James Barry, and E. A. Barry~~ and each of those persons of said real property and the only owners thereof and that the said owners join in the aforesaid petition and hereby petition and requested the Council of said Village to incorporate the said real property into the said Village, and to extend the boundaries of such Village so as to include the same and ~~all thereof~~ the whole thereof.

And there being no objection to such petition and in the judgment of the members of the Council of said Village, it is hereby that said real property shall be included within the boundaries of said Village, and that the last interests of said Village, its citizens and the public require that said petition be granted and that the boundaries of said Village be extended so as to include said property.

And all members of said Council being present and each thereof favoring the granting of said petition;

It is therefore ordered and enacted by the Village Council of the Village of Barry aforesaid that the Village boundaries of the said Village be and the same hereby are extended so as to include the above described real property and all thereof, and the boundaries of said Village are accordingly hereby extended so as to include all of said above described property.
