An ordinance made in the corporation of the Village of Barry,
Dakota County, Minnesota, so as to include certain real property in
said Village, lot 128, Range 47, in said County, Minnesota.

The Village Council of Village of Barry, Dakota County, Minnesota,
do hereby do ordain as follows:

That wherein heretofore set out on the 1st day of February, 1899
there was duly and lawfully presented to the Council of said Village
of Barry, Minnesota, a petition in writing which is copied with the
decree of said Village, signed and executed by E. J. Barry, William
Barry, James Barry, and E. A. Barry author and petitioners for the
inclusion of the said Village of Barry, Minnesota, to extend the boundaries
of said VILLAGE, so as to include lot 128 of section 10, township 128,
range 47, in said County, Minnesota.

And whereas it has been made to appear to the said council by said
petition and by other sufficient proof that the above described real
property abuts upon the said Village of Barry; that the said petition
E. J. Barry, William Barry, James Barry, and E. A. Barry and each of
them are owner of said real property and the only owners thereof who
desire the same or both jointly in the aforesaid petition and thereby petition
and requested the council of said village to incorporate the said real
property into the said village, and to extend the boundaries of such vil-
lage so as to include the same and all thereof, the whole thereof.

All those being no objection to such petition and in the judgment
of the members of the Council of said Village, it is deemed that said
real property should be included within the boundaries of said Village,
and that the boundaries of said Village, its citizens and the pub-
lic consider that said petition be granted and that the boundaries of the
said Village be extended so as to include said property.

And all members of said council present and each time of the
signing the decree of said petition;

It is therefore ordered and enacted by the Village Council of
the Village of Barry aforesaid that the Village boundaries of the said
Village so far as the same already are extended be so as to include the above
described real property and all thereof, and the boundaries of said Village
are accordingly hereby extended so as to include all of said
above described property.

It is further ordered and enacted that a copy of this ordinance be in Bill
of Lading from and after its passage, and that a certified copy
thereof be forthwith filed in office of Surveyor of said County of Minnesota.
