

I, Harry H. Peterson, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota,
do hereby appoint Joe Donahue of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special
Attorney for the State Agriculture Society to act on the State Fair
Grounds during the Fair to be held from September 1st to September 8th,
1934, and for such time as may be necessary to act at that place,
either before or after said Fair, action to be taken in all matters
that require the immediate action of an adviser to the State
Agriculture Society or of a prosecuting attorney.

This appointment is made upon recommendation of the Board of
Managers of the State Agriculture Society and upon my judgment that
the public welfare will be promoted thereby. The compensation is
hereby fixed at \$15.00 per day, to be paid from the funds of said
Society.
