I, T. L. Phelps, County Auditor of the County of Olmsted, State of Minnesota do hereby certify that at a special election of the Village of Dover, in the County of Olmsted, State of Minnesota, held on the 16th day of February, 1909, a vote was taken on the following question, " Shall the said Village of Dover separate from the Township of Dover for the purpose of becoming a separate election and assessment district," and that at said election the vote being counted, it was found that there were twenty-five ballots cast in favor of said proposition and four ballots cast against the said proposition, one ballot being spoiled, there being thirty ballots cast at the said election.

I do further certify that a statement of said special election, properly signed by the Judges and the Clerk, and the result thereof, was sent to this office the 23rd day of February, 1909.
