RESOLUTION.

Whereas, A regular election of the voters of the village of Cokato, Wright County, Minnesota, was held on the 5th day of December 1933, at the village hall in said village, due notice thereof having been given as provided by law, to vote on the reincorporation of said village pursuant to the General Laws of 1905 and amendments thereto as provided by Section 1110, Mason's Minnesota Statutes, 1927, and the votes cast at said election having been duly canvassed by the village council of said village and the results found as follows, to-wit:

Total number of votes cast .....	169
For reincorporation - Yes .....	126
For reincorporation - No .....	37

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That said village council does hereby declare that a majority of the ~~hhhhh~~ votes cast at said election was in the affirmative for reincorporation and that said village of Cokato be and hereby is declared to be reincorporated pursuant to the General Laws of 1905 and amendments ~~kk~~ thereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the county auditor of Wright County, Minnesota, and with the secretary of state.
