PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MOORHEAD, MINNESOTA

Fo the Honorable C. A. Hye, and the council of the City of Moorhead. Minnesota.

We, the undersigned, appointed on the 30th day of December A.D. 1903, by the honorable the District Court of the State of Minnesota, in and for the County of Clay, as a Charter Commission for the said City, do hereby respectfully submit the following amendments to the Charter adopted by the City of Moorhead, on the 32nd, day of May A.D. 1900, to-wit:

To amend section, 178, of chapter X11 of the Charter by adding theretes

And such cost may be paid in equal annual installments—
not less than three nor more than five — to be determined by
resolution of the council, pursuant to notice duly given. Such
installment schall bear insterest at six per cent per annum, payable
annually: Provided, that any property owner affected thereby may at
any time pay off any installment or the whole of such assessment
with accrued interest.

SECOND AMENDMENT :

Add to the end of section 170 of said chapter the following:

Provided, that 121 January 1st 1800, the council may
at any regular meeting, upon an affirmative vote of at least seven
Aldermen, and by and with the approval of the Mayor, determine by
resolution that it is necessary to make any local improvement
mentioned in section 178 of said charter without the petition of
the owners of the property to be affected by such improvement;
but before any such action shall be taken by the Council it shall
give notice of such meeting and contemplated action, on each week
day for ten days next prior to such meeting, by publication thereof
in a legal newspaper published in said city.

THIRD AMOUNDMENT S

Add to the end of section 187 of said chapter the following :

For the purpose of providing funds in advance of the

collection of the moneys to be derived from any such assessment the

Council may from time to time issue certificates of indebtedness to

be paid out of the moneys to be collected from such assessment, to

the full amount thereof; and any money in the permanent improvement

Revolving Fund shall be applied, if required to redeem said pertificates.

But such certificates shall not exceed in the agreegate the amount of such assessment, and the total amount of such certificates outstanding shall at no time exceed Sixty thousand Dollars (\$60000.); and the faith and credit of the City are irrevocably pledged to the payment of such obligations.
