

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of the County of Itasca, State of Minnesota:

Gentlemen:

To the undersigned legal voters residing within the territory and upon the land described herein, do hereby petition your Honorable Board to call an election for the determination of the incorporation of the proposed village of Coleraine, said proposed village and incorporation to include the following described lands and territory:

All of Sections Nineteen (19), Twenty (20), Twenty-nine (29), Thirty (30) and Thirty-one (31); East one-half of Section Twenty-one (21); West one-half of Section Twenty-eight (28); Southwest quarter and 6 x East one-half of the Northwest quarter, Section Thirty-two (32); all in Township fifty-six (56) north, Range twenty-four (24) west; and the north one-half of Section six (6), out the west one-half of the Northwest quarter of Section five (5); all in Township fifty-five (55) north, Range twenty-four (24) west, Itasca County, Minnesota, excepting, however, from all of the lands above described, a strip of land commencing at the intersection of the high-water shore line of Trout Lake with the east and west quarter line of said Section six (6), in Township fifty-five (55) north, Range twenty-four (24) west; thence in a general northerly, easterly, northwesterly and southerly direction along said high-water shore line of Trout Lake to the intersection thereof with the north and south quarter line of said Section Thirty-two (32) in Township fifty-six (56), Range twenty-four (24); thence west along said last mentioned quarter line a distance of sixty (60) feet; thence in a general westerly, northwesterly, southerly and southerly direction along a line parallel with and sixty (60) feet distant at all points from the high-water shore line of said Trout Lake, to the east and west quarter line of said Section six (6), Township fifty-five (55), Range twenty-four (24); thence east along said last mentioned quarter line sixty (60) feet to the place of beginning.

Four petitions have been caused to be taken on the 2nd, 12th, 18th,

10th & 17th days of March, 1898, an accurate census of the resident population of the said territory proposed to be included in said village and in said incorporation, which census was taken by August Johnson, H.G. Goodwin and A.F. McMillough, legal voters and residents on the lands and within the territory above described, and to be included within the proposed incorporation; and the persons so taking said census are among the petitioners whose signatures are hereto attached.

This a statement of said census so taken as aforesaid, setting forth accurately the names of the inhabitants, actual residents of the lands and territory above described, is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof.

The boundaries of the territory proposed to be incorporated as said village are as above set forth, with the exceptions as above stated; and the quantity of the land embraced therein is Four Thousand Three Hundred Nineteen and Fifty-one One-hundredths (4319.51) acres;

That said lands include two hundred one and seven-tenths (201.7) acres of platted land as called; that said platted lands have been duly platted into lots and blocks, as the Townsite of COLORLINE, The First Addition to Colorline, The Second Addition to Colorline, and the Third Addition to Colorline, and that the plats of said Colorline and each of said additions thereto, have been duly and legally certified, according to the laws of the State of Minnesota, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds, in and for said Itasca County; that all of said lands lie in said Itasca County;

That the descriptions of the lands above referred to as platted lands, are as follows:

The lands platted as Colorline, above mentioned, bounded as follows: Beginning at the west quarter corner of Section Thirty-two (32) Township fifty-six (56), Range twenty-four (24), west; thence north along west line of said Section Thirty-two (32) 33.7 feet to an iron pin; thence east at an angle to the left of  $99^{\circ} 56' 30''$ , 1904.8 feet to an iron pin; thence south at an angle to the left of  $90^{\circ}$  500 feet to an iron pin; thence southwest at an angle to the left of  $107^{\circ} 34'$  324.98 feet to an iron pin;

thence southward at an angle to the left of  $108^{\circ}$  268.66 feet to an iron pin; thence westerly at an angle to the left of  $107^{\circ} 48' 30.7$  feet to an iron pin; thence southwest at an angle to the left of  $285^{\circ} 40'$  884.46 feet to an iron pin; thence west at an angle to the left of  $119^{\circ} 8' 30"$ , 1084.6 feet to an iron pin on the west line of said Section Thirty-two (32), 68.2 feet north of the Government meander corner; thence north along the west line of said Section Thirty-two (32) at an angle to the left of  $67^{\circ} 6' 30"$ , 1029.1 feet to the aforesaid west one-quarter corner of Section Thirty-two (32), Township Fifty-six (56) north, Range Twenty-four (24) west, the point of beginning and containing in all about Thirty-nine and two-tenths (39.2) acres.

The lands platted as the First Addition to Coleraine, above mentioned, bounded as follows: beginning at the east one-quarter corner of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Fifty-six (56) north, Range twenty-four (24) west; thence south along the east line of said Section Thirty-one at an angle to the left of  $88^{\circ}$  from the east end west one-quarter line of said section thirty-one (31), 1029.1 foot to an iron pin marking the point of intersection of said Section line with the south line of Cole Avenue; thence west along the south line of Cole Avenue at an angle to the left of  $82^{\circ} 44' 30"$ , 1094.78 feet to an iron pin; thence north at an angle to the left of  $90^{\circ}$ , 737.38 feet to an iron pin; thence north and east along a circular curve of radius 709.40 feet, whose tangent at the point of its intersection with the preceding course, lies at an angle to the left of  $148^{\circ} 7' 30"$ , 681.06 feet to an iron pin, marking the point of intersection of said curve with the east and west one-quarter line of said Section Thirty-one (31) the tangent to the curve at this point lying parallel to the south line of Corey Avenue; thence easterly along said one-quarter line at an angle to the left of  $179^{\circ} 8' 30"$  from the tangent to the curve 569.2 feet to the east one-quarter corner of said Section Thirty-one (31), place of beginning, and containing in all about twenty-five and two-tenths (25.2) acres.

The lands platted as the Second Addition to Coleraine, above men-

tiered, bounded as follows; beginning at a point on the east section line of Section Thirty-one (31), Township fifty-six (56) north, Range twenty-four (24) east, north of the north meander corner of said section line and sixty (60) feet from the high-water shore line of Trout Lake; thence northerly along said section line to an iron pin marking the point of intersection of said section line with the south line of Cole Avenue, as defined in the plat of the First Addition to Coleraine above described; thence due west along said south line of Cole Avenue 944.78 feet to an iron pin; thence due south 1000.08 feet to an iron pin; thence south  $40^{\circ} 44' 4''$  east 700.00 feet to an iron pin marking the point of intersection of the south line of Congdon Avenue with the south section line of Section Thirty-one (31) aforesaid; this point being 936.02 feet west of the southeast corner of said section Thirty-one (31); thence continuing on same course 1015.81 feet to an iron pin; thence due east 247.58 feet to an iron pin; thence due north 442.12 feet to an iron pin; thence north  $10^{\circ} 46' 52''$  west 376.7 feet to an iron pin; thence northwesterly along a circular curve of radius 1043.08 feet, whose tangent at its beginning coincides with the preceding course, 101.10 feet to an iron pin, marking the point of the intersection of the said curve with the east section line of Section Thirty-one (31) aforesaid this point being 632.71 feet north of the southeast corner of said Section Thirty-one (31); thence north  $5^{\circ} 11' 32''$  east along said section line to a point sixty (60) feet distant southerly from the high-water shore line of Trout Lake; thence on an irregular line parallel to and sixty (60) feet from the said high-water shore line of said Trout Lake to the place of beginning, and containing in all about Forty-three and seven-tenths (43.7) acres.

The lands platted as the Third Addition to Coleraine, above mentioned, bounded as follows: Beginning at the iron pin marking the point of the intersection of the south and west boundaries of the First Addition to Coleraine, above described, said point being on the south line of Cole Avenue, 1094.78 feet west of its intersection with the east section line of said Section Thirty-one (31); thence due north along said west boundary

of the First Addition to Coleraine sixty-six (66) feet to an iron pin; thence due west along a prolongation of the north line of Cole Avenue 310.15 feet to an iron pin; thence north  $78^{\circ} 10' 45''$  west 980.48 feet to an iron pin; thence north  $68^{\circ} 48' 45''$  west 207.6 feet to an iron pin; thence due west 1521.68 feet to an iron pin; thence due south 1847 feet to an iron pin; thence due east 1099.77 feet to an iron pin marking the point of intersection of the south line of McCarthy Avenue with the north and south one-quarter line of said section Thirty-one (31), said point being 43.14 feet north of the south one-quarter corner of said Section Thirty-one (31); thence continuing on same course 1138.23 feet to an iron pin; thence due north 1581.57 feet to an iron pin; thence south  $78^{\circ} 10' 45''$  east 803.31 feet to an iron pin; thence due east 316.83 feet to the place of beginning and containing in all about Ninety-Three and Six-Tenths (93.6) acres.

That the unplatte portion of the territory herein above described, and proposed to be included in said incorporation adjoins the platted portion thereof, above described and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

That the number of the actual residents on all of the territory above described, proposed to be included in said village and incorporation is fifteen hundred and seventy-seven; and that the number of actual residents upon the platted portions thereof above described, is ten hundred and fifty-seven; and that the resident population of all of said territory so proposed to be incorporated is not more than Three Thousand (3000) nor less than Two Hundred (200) and the resident population of said platted portions thereof is not more than Three Thousand (3000) nor less than Two Hundred (200).

That none of the lands or territory above described is already incorporated, nor is any part thereof within the limits of any incorporated village, city or borough.

That the nucleus of the population of said lands and territory proposed to be so incorporated as a village is on the platted lands above described.

That the undersigned petitioners are all actual residents and legal

vetero of said territory.

That the name of said proposed village is COLORAINE.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners ask that your honorable board proceed according to law to call an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation of said village of Coloraine, and that you take all the steps and proceedings required by law for such purpose.

A petition was presented for the incorporation of certain territory into a municipal incorporation to be named the Village of Coleraine and requesting the board to fix a time and place when and where the voters residing within said territory might vote for or against such incorporation.

Commissioner Trellecock offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

"Whereas, August Johnson and thirty-four other persons, legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, have made and filed with the county auditor, as clerk of this board, and presented to this board a petition, signed by them, setting forth, among other things, that said petitioners are legal voters residing within said territory; that said petitioners have caused to be taken by three of said petitioners on March 12, 13, 15, 16 and 17, 1909, an accurate census of the resident population of all of Sections nineteen (19), twenty (20), twenty-nine (29), thirty (30) and thirty-one (31), West half of Section twenty-one (21), West half of Section twenty-eight (28), Southwest quarter (SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and West half of Northwest quarter (W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section thirty-two (32), all in Township fifty-six (56) North, Range twenty-four (24) West, and North half (N  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section six (6) and West half of Northwest quarter (W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section five (5), all in Township fifty-five (55) North, Range twenty-four (24) West, Itasca county, Minnesota, excepting, however, from all of the lands above described a strip of land commencing at the intersection of the high-water shore line of Trout lake, with the east and west quarter line of said Section six (6), in Township fifty-five (55) North, Range twenty-four (24) West, thence in a general northerly, easterly, northwesterly and easterly direction along said high-water shore line of Trout lake to the intersection thereof with the north and south quarter line of said Section thirty-two (32), in Township fifty-six (56), Range twenty-four (24), thence north along said last mentioned quarter line a distance of sixty feet, thence in a general westerly, southeasterly, westerly and southerly direction along a line parallel with and sixty feet distant at all points from the high-water shore line of said Trout lake, to the east and west quarter line of said Section six (6), Township fifty-five (55), Range twenty-four (24), thence east along said last mentioned quarter line sixty (60) feet to the place of beginning, a statement of which census is attached to said petition and made a part thereof; that the boundaries of the territory proposed to be incorporated as

a village are as above set forth, with the exception above mentioned, and the quantity of land embraced therein is 4319.51 acres; that said lands embrace 201.7 acres of platted lands, duly platted as the townsite of "Coleraine," "the First Addition to Coleraine," "the Second Addition to Coleraine," and "the Third Addition to Coleraine," in said petition more particularly described, and that the plats of said Coleraine and each of said additions thereto have been duly and legally certified and filed in the office of the register of deeds of said county; that the unplatted portion of the territory above described adjoins the platted portions thereof and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government; that the number of actual residents on all of said territory proposed to be incorporated is 1577, and the number of actual residents on the platted portions thereof is 1057; that the resident population of all of said territory and the resident population of said platted portions are each not more than 3000 nor less than 200; that none of the said territory is already incorporated nor is any part thereof within the limits of any incorporated village, city or borough; that the nucleus of the population of said territory is on the platted portions thereof; that it is proposed and desired to incorporate all of said territory above described, with the exception above stated, as a village; and that the name of said proposed village is "Coleraine;" and praying that this board proceed according to law to call an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation and take all steps and proceedings required by law for such purpose - which said petition is duly verified by the oaths of three of said petitioners, declaring that such census was accurately taken on the dates specified and that the statements made in said petition are true;

"And, whereas, this board, after duly considering said matter, is of the opinion and does hereby determine that the contents of said petition, including the statement of said census, are true, and that it is expedient and for the best interests of the residents of said territory that said petition be granted and that an election should be duly called and held for the determination of such proposed incorporation and all further

steps and proceedings taken required by law for such purpose, and does approve said petition:

"Now, therefore, be it resolved that said petition, and the whole thereof, be and it is hereby approved; that the 17th day of April, 1909, ~~be and it is hereby appointed~~ between the hours of ten o'clock A.M., at which time the polls shall open, and four o'clock P.M., at which time the polls shall close, and the frame building known as the "fire hall," situated on the rear of Lot twelve (12) of Block six (6) of the Original Townsite of Coleraine, in said county and state, within the boundaries of said territory proposed to be incorporated, be and they are hereby fixed as the time and place for holding an election of the legal voters residing within said territory proposed to be incorporated, for the purpose of determining whether all of said territory shall be so incorporated as the village of "Coleraine;" that an election be so held at the time and place and for the purpose aforesaid; and that the county auditor of said county be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue and cause to be posted in three public places within the boundaries of the territory above described, not less than twenty nor more than thirty days prior to the date so fixed for said election, and to be published in the "Coleraine Optic," a qualified weekly newspaper published within said boundaries, for two successive weeks, the first publication to be at least two weeks prior to the date so fixed, a notice of said election, specifying and fixing the time and place thereof, as aforesaid, and containing all other details required by law, including a specification of the purpose of said election and a description of the territory proposed to be incorporated, together with a copy of said petition, attached to said notice;

"Be it further resolved that W. J. Trescott,

George Smith and E. J. Anderson,

residents and legal voters of the territory so proposed to be incorporated, be and they are hereby appointed inspectors, to act as judges of said election, conduct the same in accordance with law and perform all other duties by law required and specified."

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Commissioner O'Brien and carried by unanimous vote.



The lands platted as the Third Addition to Coleraine, above mentioned, bounded as follows: Beginning at the iron pin marking the point of the intersection of the east and west boundaries of the First Addition to Coleraine, above described, said point being on the south line of Cole Avenue, 1076.78 feet west of its intersection with the east section line of said Section Thirty-one (31); thence due north along said west boundary

of the First Addition to Colordine sixty-six (66) feet to an iron pin; thence due west along a prolongation of the north line of Cole Avenue 310.15 feet to an iron pin; thence north  $78^{\circ} 16' 45''$  west 980.48 feet to an iron pin; thence north  $63^{\circ} 48' 45''$  west 207.5 feet to an iron pin; thence due west 1531.68 feet to an iron pin; thence due south 1047 feet to an iron pin; thence due east 1099.77 feet to an iron pin marking the point of intersection of the south line of McCarthy Avenue with the north and south one-quarter line of said section Thirty-one (31), said point being 48.14 feet north of the south one-quarter corner of said Section Thirty-one (31); thence continuing on same course 1142.23 feet to an iron pin; thence due north 1581.57 feet to an iron pin; thence south  $78^{\circ} 16' 45''$  east 208.31 feet to an iron pin; thence due east 310.93 feet to the place of beginning and containing in all about Ninety-Three and Six-Tenths (93.6) acres.

That the unplatte portion of the territory herein above described, and proposed to be included in said incorporation adjoins the platted portion thereof, above described and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

That the number of the actual residents on all of the territory above described, proposed to be included in said village and incorporation is fifteen hundred and seventy-seven; and that the number of actual residents upon the platted portions thereof above described, is ten hundred and fifty-seven; and that the resident population of all of said territory as proposed to be incorporated is not more than Three Thousand (3000) nor less than Two Hundred (200) and the resident population of said platted portions thereof is not more than Three Thousand (3000) nor less than Two Hundred (200).

That none of the lands or territory above described is already incorporated, nor is any part thereof within the limits of any incorporated village, city or borough.

That the nucleus of the population of said lands and territory proposed to be as incorporated as a village is on the platted lands above described.

That the undersigned petitioners are all actual residents and legal

voters of said territory.

That the name of said proposed village is COLERAINE.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners ask that your honorable board proceed according to law to call an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation of said village of Coleraine, and that you take all the steps and proceedings required by law for such purpose.






