PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE OF GILBERT.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF
ST. LOUIS IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

THE UNDERSIGNED, legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, desire that said territory shall become incorporated as a village under chapter 9 of the Revised Laws of the State of Minnesota of the year 1905, as amended, and to that end request that your honorable body shall call an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation.

We have caused to be taken a correct census of the resident population of said territory and the census so taken shows the resident population to be 491; said census was taken on the 29th day of March, 1909.

The boundaries of the territory proposed to be incorporated are those tracts of land in the county of St. Louis and state of Minnesota, described as follows, to wit: Southwest quarter of southeast quarter and southeast quarter of southwest quarter of section twenty-three in township fifty-eight north of range seventeen west of 4th p. m., more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of southwest quarter of section 23 township 58 north of range 17 west of 4th p.m.; thence due east along south boundary line of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of said section 1283.22 feet; thence north $1^{\circ} 43' 25''$ East 1327.20 feet along East boundary of said forty to northeast corner of said forty; thence north $89^{\circ} 55' 55''$ West 1313.49 feet along north boundary of said forty to northwest corner of said forty; thence north $89^{\circ} 56' 55''$ West 1292.22 feet along north boundary of southeast quarter of southwest quarter of said section to northwest corner of said forty; thence south $0^{\circ} 2' 54''$ West 1330.97 feet along west boundary of said forty to southwest corner of said forty; thence north $89^{\circ} 55' 45''$ East
