AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF ADDITIONAL  
TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF NEWPORT, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

SECTION 1.

Be it ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Newport,  
Washington County, Minnesota, that the following described territory  
lying South of and abounding on said Village between the West line of  
Cottage Grove Township and the Mississippi River and running South  
~~Eighty (80) rods~~ *and 160 Rods East then of*

Lying between the right of way of the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul  
Railway and the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railway and North of the  
Cottage Grove Road, Blocks one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4),  
five (5), six (6), seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11),  
twelve (12), thirteen (13), and fourteen (14), and part of S. W. 1/4  
of N. W. 1/4 section one (1), Town twenty seven (27), Range twenty two (22)
