To His Excellency, Floyd B. Olson,
Governor of the State of Minnesota.

The State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors of Minnesota respectfully submits this, its thirteenth annual report with attached roster of registrants, as required by law.

This Board is organized under the provisions of Chapter 523, session laws of 1921, as amended by Chapter 401, session laws of 1933, and is in response to the growing public interest to properly recognize the professions named above, and to safeguard the lives, the health, and the property of the citizens of Minnesota.

Registration in Minnesota is in support of a nation-wide movement. Thirty-three states of the United States now have registration laws for architects, twenty-seven states for engineers, and twenty-two states for land surveyors. Thirty-eight states now have registration laws.

It is evident the Legislature, in the exercise of the police power of the state, may prescribe regulations for securing the admission of qualified persons to all callings demanding special knowledge, experience, and skill. Evidence in support of this statement is found in the opinion of the Supreme Court of the United States, No. 320, October Term, 1926, "The power of the State to provide for the general welfare of its people, authorizes it to prescribe all such regulations as, in its judgment, will secure or tend to secure them against the consequences of ignorance and incapacity as well as of deception and fraud. As one means to this end it has been the practice of different States, from time immemorial, to exact in many pursuits a certain degree of skill and learning upon which the community may confidently rely, their possession being generally ascertained upon an examination of parties by competent persons, x x x. The nature and extent of the qualifications required must depend primarily upon the judgment of the State as to their necessity."

The rapid development of the state and the increasing magnitude of public works of an engineering and architectural character, and the expenditure of public moneys in construction, make necessary the protection of the registration law, not only for the public, but for the legitimate professional engineer, the architect, and the land surveyor.

The active co-operation of the state, county, and municipal authorities, as well as the professional architect, engineer, and land surveyor, is urged that the law may reflect credit to the state and to the respective professions.

The administration of the law is carried on without legislative appropriation, and it is therefore distinctly to the credit of the architectural, engineering, and land surveying professions that legitimate practitioners are not only willing to register, but willing to pay to register. It is evidence not only of the good will, but of the will of professional men to support the law.
