to serve, subject to my general supervision and control and at my pleasure, as editor and manager, to collect, compile, disseminate and publish statistics and information germane to the purposes of the act set forth as Chapter 376, Laws of 1933, including the publication of a department journal or magazine for the publication of matter pertaining to conservation, pursuant to the intents and purposes of aforesaid law, and subject to the obligation of a bond providing for the faithful discharge of such duties, and pay over without delay to the officer entitled by law thereto the sum of not less than \$5,000.00.
