PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, financial independence is sought by and for all citizens, and

WHEREAS, we just now are emerging from a distressing period when we particularly have had brought home to us the need for, and wisdom of making provision for our own financial futures, and the futures of those dependent upon us, and

WHEREAS, because of these experiences, it is especially fitting that we should be giving more study as individuals, and as a commonwealth, to ways and means of achieving financial independence, and should be planning our individual and collective futures;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, designate and declare the week of March 19 to 24, 1934, as

FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE WEEK

and invite you, and every citizen of the State, to participate in, and take advantage of the educational programs on the subject of financial independence which during the week will be presented in cities throughout Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed, at St. Paul, this 19th day of March, 1934.
