

The following resolution was on motion duly adopted by unanimous vote of all members present:-


Be It Resolved, by the Village Council of the Village of Lakefield, County of Jackson, and State of Minnesota, that we do hereby certify and return, that at a special election held at the town hall in said Village of Lakefield, Jackson County, Minnesota, on the Friday of May, 21st, 1909, to vote on the question whether said Village of Lakefield, shall continue to exist under the general act of the Legislature and amendments thereto incorporating the same, or shall become re-incorporated under the Revised Laws of 1898, the following number of votes were cast for and against said proposition, as canvassed by said Village Council, to-wit:-

For Re-incorporation—~~2~~ 33 votes.
Against Re-incorporation—~~1~~ 1 vote.

and that said election be and hereby is declared carried in favor of such re-incorporation under the said Revised Laws of 1898.
